She has participated in international conferences and scholarly projects related to small cinemas and has organized international conferences on the subject at the University of Western Ontario in 2011 and at the Jagiellonian University in 2016 in cooperation with the University of Economics and Humanities in Bielsko-Biala. At present Professor Falkowska teaches film and media in English and Polish at the University of Economics and Humanities in Bielsko-Biala.

She has been the international organizer of the Small Cinemas conference since 2011.
